
Effective March 31, 2014, Canada Post rates will increase. To keep the Welfare Plan operating costs down and quick reimbursements, we encourage Members' to enroll in our PAD program:

- Pre-authorized deposit (PAD) lets your claim reimbursement be deposited <u>directly</u> into your bank account instead of receiving a claim cheque in the mail.
- Pre-authorized deposit eliminates the possibility of lost or stolen cheque/mail and is environmentally friendly.
- Pre-authorized deposits can only be used to deposit money into your bank account.
   NO money can be withdrawn from your bank account.
